EAST COLEBROK – Jeffrey K. Fellows, 53, of Colebrook, died unexpectedly on Friday, March 15, 2024, at his home.

He was born on Feb. 23, 1971, in Lancaster, NH. He was raised in Stewartstown from a young age and attended schools in Colebrook.

Following high school, Jeff began working as a factory laborer at Tillotson Rubber Co. in Dixville, and through the years did just about every job there, rising to the position of machine tender and a substitute foreman.
