



## Jeffrey L. Weston

April 30, 1954 - May 21, 2011

COLEBROOK, NH -- Mr. Jeffrey L. "Lincoln" Weston, 57, of Colebrook, NH, passed away on Saturday morning, May 21, 2011, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook, NH, with his loving wife and friends by his side after a five year period of ill health.

He was born in Kittery, Me., on April 30, 1954, a son to Robert Weston and Ruth (Lincoln) Weston. He was raised and educated in the seacoast area of NH.

In his early years, Jeffrey traveled extensively, living and working all around the U.S., and finally settled in the north country about twenty-four years ago. With his friend Gary Carlson, they established North Country Plumbing & Heating in Colebrook, and Jeffrey worked there as a partner and master plumber until illness prevented him from doing so.

He was an avid hunter and fisherman, and he loved to travel and ride motorcycles. Although he would often tell his children that he was "mean, rotten and ugly," Jeffrey had a heart of gold and he loved life. He was a very generous person, even to a fault. He was also well known for his distinctive laugh.
