



Jesse "Buddy" L. Cass, Jr.

October 20, 1938 - January 20, 2007

Mr. Jesse "Buddy" L. Cass, Jr., 68, of Lindenhurst, New York, formerly of Columbia and Colebrook, New Hampshire, passed away January 20, 2007 in Lindenhurst. Buddy was born October 20, 1938, in Columbia, NH, son of the late Jesse L. Cass, Sr. and Lillian N. (Coates) Cass. Buddy graduated from Colebrook Academy in 1956, and in January of 1957, he enlisted in the United States Air Force, serving honorably for four years of which two years were spent in Japan. He worked for Burroughs Corporation and also for Timeplex, Inc. For a short period of time, he owned and operated a Bowling Pro Shop in Garden City, NY, while later working for Uniondale Union Free School District until his illness required him to stop working in June 2006. Buddy is survived by his wife, Carol E. (Reid) Cass of Lindenhurst, NY; seven children, Cathy Cass, Linda Michelson and Michael Cass, all of Michigan, Danielle Douglas of Arizona, Tracey Cass of Wisconsin, Christine Hackelberg of Maryland and Cherie Hackelberg of California; four sisters, Leis Mullek of Alabama, Margaret Kenney and Geraldine Pettingill, both of Washington, and Marilla Dorman of Colebrook; and sixteen grandchildren.
