W. STEWARTSTOWN – Joanne M. Stone, 94, of Lemington, passed away peacefully at the Coös County Nursing Hospital in West Stewartstown on Tuesday, April 22, 2025, after a long period of declining health.

She was born in Newport, Vt., on March 23, 1931, a daughter to the late Wilfred and Natalie (Corkum) Stone. She was a graduate of Canaan Memorial High School in 1949 and later a graduate of Northampton College in Northampton, Mass.

Her business experiences included employment in the export division of United Aircraft in Hartford, Conn., the Rohr Corporation in San Diego, Calif., the Washington, D.C., office of General Tire & Rubber, and 17 years as the shareholders relations manager for the Charter Oil Co., of Jacksonville, Fla. Upon her retirement, Joanne returned to Colebrook to live with her sister and mother.

Joanne is predeceased by her sister, Sandy Stone.
