



John Kirk Worrall III

COLEBROOK – John Kirk Worrall, III, 64, of Colebrook, died at his home on Saturday, June 7, 2025, after a long battle with complications from heart conditions, and with his wife at his side.

He was born in Newburyport, Mass., on Dec. 27, 1960, a son to the late John K. and Patricia (Burnham) Worrall, Jr. He was raised in Newburyport and graduated from high school in 1980.

Kirk then attended culinary school and obtained his associate degree in culinary arts. He worked for many restaurants on the north shore for the next 15 years, before changing careers and working as an extruder for Skandia Plastics in Plaistow, N.H. He met his wife, Cecile, in Exeter and they resided there for a time and later in Barrington, eventually moving to Cecile's home in the north country in 2014. Kirk then began working for W.W. Berry as a school bus driver in Colebrook.

He was an avid sports fan, especially NASCAR, his favorite car being the #3 car driven by Dale Earnhardt. He also loved hockey as a devoted Bruins fan. He also loved watching the Patriots play football, as well as cheering on the Boston Red Sox and the Boston Celtics. Kirk also enjoyed playing golf, taking trips for vacation, especially to the Poconos mountains. He was very close to his wife's family and loved spending time at family events.

Kirk is survived by his wife of 24 years, Cecile (Bissonnette) Worrall of Colebrook; a step-son, Ghislaine Fillion of New Mexico; a brother, Dennis Worrall of Maine; a beloved nephew that he considered as his own grandson, Mason Burrill; as well as numerous other nieces and nephews.

He is predeceased by a sister, Donna Worrall, as a child.

There are no public calling hours. A graveside interment service will be held on Friday, June 13, 2025, at 1 p.m. in St. Albert's Catholic Cemetery in W. Stewartstown.
