COLEBROOK, NH— Mr. John G. Hipp, 68, of Colebrook, NH, passed away on Wednesday afternoon, May 9, 2012, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook, with his family by his side.

He was born in New Milford, Conn., on October 11, 1943, a son to the late William and Ida (Gregory) Hipp. He grew up and was educated in Connecticut, and he served with honor in the U.S. Air Force.
