November 28, 1958 - December 4, 1979

Airman First Class Jonathan H. Howes of Enfield, CT, will be reinterred at the South Canaan Cemetery in Canaan, VT, on July 25, 2003. He died on December 4, 1979, at the age of 21.

Airman Howes was born in Hartford, CT, on November 28, 1958. He was a graduate of Lyndon Institute in Lyndonville, VT, where he was a boarding student. He was stationed at Pease Air Force Base in Portsmouth at the time of his death.

Airman Howes was an avid fly fisherman, hunter and lover of the outdoors. While in the service, he was attending college to earn a degree to become a Fish and Game officer. The family's warmest and fondest memories of him were at their camp on Big Averill Lake, where he spent his summers with his mother and family. It has always been the family's wish to have him return to the North Country that he loved.
