



Joseph "Hector" Caron

August 13, 1929 - May 15, 2005

Mr. Joseph "Hector" Caron, 75, of Bloomfield, Vermont, passed away Sunday afternoon, May 15, 2005, at his home surrounded by his family. Mr. Caron was born August 13, 1929, in St. Justine, P.Q., Canada, son of the late Joseph Fulbert and Marie Alice (Auclair) Caron. Mr. Caron served honorably in the United States Army during the Korean War, receiving the Army Occupation Medal and the Good Conduct Medal. Following his discharge, he moved to Manchester where he delivered furniture and worked for International Paper Company. He then returned to the North Country and worked in the woods and also as a superintendent at the Stratford Plywood Mill. He then moved to Pennsylvania for a short period of time and worked in construction, ultimately moving back to Vermont and working for Ethan Allen. He was talented in the areas of carpentry and plumbing and was an avid outdoorsman. He built his home and discount store in Bloomfield where he worked along side his wife until his health deteriorated, resulting in his retirement.
