



Joseph "Joe" F. Tamulonis

WILSONS MILLS, MAINE -- Mr. Joseph "Joe" F. Tamulonis, 94, of Wilsons Mills, Maine, passed away on Thursday, May 28, 2009, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook, NH.

Joe was born in Boston, Mass., on August 10, 1914, a son of the late Cyprus and Monica Tamulonis.

He was educated in Fitchburg, Mass., and served with honor in the U.S. Navy during World War II. Following his service, he entered college and became a mechanical engineer; and he applied his skills during his career in the textile industry, both in Maine and in Massachusetts. He eventually retired from the Fitchburg Yarn Company.

After having loved this area as a young man, with its abundant fishing and hunting, Joe moved to Wilsons Mills, Me., in 1979. He spent many, many wonderful years of his retirement there. Joe was an avid hunter and fisherman, and he loved to be outdoors. When not outdoors, he could often be found watching sports, whereas he was a fan of many different types of sports. He will be remembered by all as a "happy-go-lucky" man who lived every day to the fullest.

Mr. Tamulonis leaves behind his wife of 40 years, Claire (Leger) Tamulonis; a

daughter, Joanne Caisse of Templeton, Mass.; a sister, Alice Steele of Fl.; three grandchildren; six great-grandchildren; as well as nieces and nephews.

At the request of the family, there are no calling hours or public services. A private interment will be at the convenience of the family in the Lincoln Plantation Cemetery in Wilsons Mills, Me.
