STRATFORD – June A. Fluery, 98, of Stratford, died peacefully at her home after a long period of declining health on Friday, Sept. 25, 2020.

She was born in Columbia, NH, on June 3, 1922, a daughter to the late Melrose A. and Alice (Berry) Gould. She attended the rural schools in Columbia and East Colebrook.

June was a dedicated homemaker for her family for her entire life. She will always be remembered as a wonderful cook, making everything from scratch and even on just a wood stove until 1964.
