BRUNSWICK, VT— June C. Hook, 81, of Brunswick, Vt., passed away on Sunday, Jan. 29, 2017, at the Dartmouth-Hitchcock Medical Center in Lebanon, NH, after a brief illness and with her family by her side.

She was born in Groveton on June 1, 1935, and was the daughter of Benjamin and Mabel Merrill. She was raised in the Groveton area and attended Groveton schools.

June was a devoted wife, mother, mother-in-law, sister, aunt, grandmother and great-grandmother who always cared about others first and will be missed by all who knew her. She was a cat and dog lover, especially her German Shepard, and she loved to spend time caring for her African violets. She cherished time with her grandchildren, and June loved to be at home. June was an accomplished swimmer, and she had a wonderful sense of humor. She was very civic-minded, as well, and held many posts in her community, including as town auditor, ballot clerk, as a Justice of the Peace in Vermont, and she was an EMT on the local ambulance corps for several years.

She is survived by her husband of 65 years, Kenneth Hook of Brunswick, Vt.; two children, Dean Hook and wife Claudette of Brunswick, and Deborah Tetreault and husband Michael of Brunswick; three grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren.

She is preceded in death by four sisters, Ruth Watters, Thelma Johnstone, Edna Roy and Eleanor Wall.
