COLEBROOK – Katherine Mae Tilton Campbell, 69, passed away on Friday evening, April 22, 2016, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook, with her family by her side and after a period of failing health.

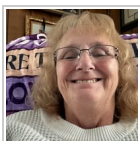
