PITTSBURG — Katherine E. von Dohrmann, 'Katie', 44, passed away peacefully on Thursday, Aug. 17, 2017, at the Coös County Nursing Home after a courageous lifelong battle with brain cancer.

Katie was born in Plattsburgh, NY, on Feb. 15, 1973, a daughter to Albert and Elizabeth (Taeger) vonDohrmann. She attended Pittsburg High School, graduating in 1991. While there, she enjoyed working in the cafeteria. She also enjoyed many summers at Deer Mountain Campground spending time with her grandparents.
