COLEBROOK, NEW HAMPSHIRE -- Kelly Lynn Blake Cass, 43, of Colebrook, New Hampshire, passed away early Tuesday morning, September 11, 2007, at the Dartmouth-Hitchcock Medical Center in Lebanon with her loving husband by her side.
