WEST STEWARTSTOWN, NEW HAMPSHIRE – Mr. Kenneth J. Bushaw, 77, of West Stewartstown, New Hampshire, formerly of North Stratford, New Hampshire, passed away Sunday afternoon, June 1, 2008, at the Coos County Nursing Hospital in West Stewartstown.

Mr. Bushaw was born November 3, 1930, in Groveton, NH, a son of the late Percy and Lena (Hampton) Bushaw.

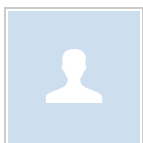
