December 15, 1919 - May 13, 2010

CANAAN, VT – Mr. Kenneth U. Hann, 90, of Canaan, Vt., passed away on Thursday morning, May 13, 2010, at the Dartmouth-Hitchcock Medical Center in Lebanon, NH.

He was born in Herford, Quebec, on December 15, 1919, a son George and Abbie (Wheeler) Hann. Kenneth came to New Hampshire with his parents as a youngster and graduated from Canaan High School.

He married Irene Harmon on June 22, 1941, and soon moved to Canaan. He served with honor in the U.S. Army during World War II. He was a member of the American Legion Post 47. Kenneth also worked or more than 35 years at the Beecher Falls Division of Ethan Allen.

He was an avid golfer, and in his earlier years enjoyed snowmobiling, hunting and fishing.

He leaves behind his son Kenneth Kirkland Hann of Canaan.

Mr. Hann is preceded in death by his wife, Irene in 1998; a brother, Stanley O Hann in 2003; and a sister, Arlene Washburn Shields in 2006.

held on Monday, May 24, 2010, at 11 a.m. at the Colebrook Village Cemetery with The Rev. Robert Lee officiating.
