



Larry D. Mickelboro

August 26, 1944 - March 27, 2022

CANAAN – Larry D. Mickelboro, 77, of Canaan, VT., passed away peacefully at his home on Sunday morning, March 27, 2022, after a period of declining health, surrounded by his family.

He was born on Aug. 26, 1944, in West Stewartstown, N.H., a son to the late Roy and Margaret (Mayberry) Mickelboro.

Larry was educated in Canaan, then ventured off to barber school and began working at Raymond's Barbershop in Concord, N.H. In March 1980, he opened Larry's Barber Shop in Penacook, N.H., owning and operating it until his retirement. He always said, "It was better than having a job," referring to his many customers who become life-long friends along the way.

He enjoyed traveling, golfing, snowmobiling, but most of all he enjoyed time spent with his friends and family.

Larry is survived by his daughter, Beth Mickelboro, of New Boston, N.H.; a granddaughter, Morgan Derome; by his companion of many years, Sally Connor; and many friends and family.

His wife Elizabeth (Connor) Mickelboro predeceased him in 1990.
