WEST STEWARTSTOWN, NEW HAMPSHIRE – Mrs. Laura M. (Duquette) Cross, 93, of West Stewartstown, New Hampshire, formerly of Colebrook, New Hampshire, passed away early Sunday, December 30, 2007, at the Coos County Nursing Hospital with her sister, Lorraine, and faithful niece, JoAnn Davis, by her side.

Mrs. Cross was born August 12, 1914, in St. Hermeneglide, P.Q., Canada, daughter of the late Narcisse and Rosianne (DeBlois) Duquette.

Mrs. Cross attended school in Beecher Falls, VT, living on Hall Stream Road. She waitressed at the Colebrook House while also owning the George Parker Farm with her late husband, Harold Cross. They later owned and operated Camp Otter for 20 years. In 1984, she moved to Colebrook and it wasn't until poor health recently resulted in her move to West Stewartstown with her sister, Lorraine. She loved her annual vacation with Bob and JoAnn Davis, her sister, Lorraine, and Florence Gadwah. She also enjoyed making crafts, sewing, and spending time with her grand-nieces and grand-nephews.

Mrs. Cross is survived by two sisters, Lorraine Duquette of West Stewartstown, and Rose Guay of Sherbrooke, P.Q., Canada; three nieces, Pauline Guay of Sherbrooke, P.Q., Canada, JoAnn Davis of Colebrook, and Betty Nicholson of Pittsburg, NH; and numerous grand-nieces and grand-

She is preceded in death by her parents and her loving husband, Harold Cross, in 1969.
