



## Lawrence L. Morehouse Sr.

April 28, 1929 - March 21, 2014

NORTH STRATFORD, NH – Lawrence L. Morehouse, Sr., 84, of North Stratford, passed away at his home on Friday, March 21, 2014, after a long period of declining health.

He was born in Warrensburg, NY, on April 28, 1929, a son to the late Chauncey and Edna (Done) Morehouse. After his education, he served for a time in the National Guard.
