BLOOMFIELD— Lefty A. Marshall, 33, of Bloomfield, Vt., died tragically on Wednesday, Sept. 6, 2023, as a result of injuries from a motor vehicle accident on Rt. 110 in Stark, N.H.

Lefty was born on Feb. 2, 1990, in Colebrook, the only child of the late Robert S. and Penny A. (Beauchemin) Marshall. He grew up in Bloomfield and was a 2008 graduate of North Stratford High School.

Lefty worked in the construction sector, particularly for concrete companies. He was employed for a time in the Burlington, Vt., area with his father, but returned to the north country and worked for VR Concrete, and most recently for Swallow & Sons Concrete in Stark.

He loved to fish and ride his ATV. Lefty had a heart of gold and was known to go out of his way to help anybody who needed it. He would do anything to be of help to someone else. But his pride and joy in life was most certainly his young son, Leo, who he was raising on his own.

Lefty leaves behind his son, Leo Marshall; his best friend and cousin, T.J. Paquette and aunt Lynda Paquette of Bloomfield; his grandmother, Loretta (Washburn) Pecararo of Colebrook; his aunts and uncles, Lane and Carolyn Marshall of Richmond, Vt., and Paul and June Marshall of Enfield, N.H., and

Marc Pecararo of Colebrook.
