NORTH STRATFORD, NEW HAMPSHIRE -- Mr. Lenwood W. Bresette III, 45, of Pleasant Valley Road, North Stratford, New Hampshire, passed away tragically early Tuesday morning, March 25, 2008, at his home in North Stratford.

Mr. Bresette was born July 13, 1962, in West Stewartstown, NH, son of Lenwood W. Bresette, Jr. and Lillian (Brooks) Bresette.

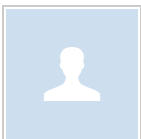
