



Leona "Leo" Beloin

May 19, 1959 - November 22, 2011

THE COLONY, TEX. — Leona “Leo” Beloin, 52, of The Colony, Tex., and formerly of Pittsburg, passed away at her home on Tuesday, November 22, 2011, surrounded by her very dear friends and family, and after a long, strong battle with cancer.

She was born in Colebrook on May 19, 1959, the youngest daughter of Alcide and Yvette (Maurais) Beloin. She grew up on the family farm, attended St. Albert’s School in Stewartstown, and graduated from Pittsburg High School. She later attended Concord Nursing School, and later graduated from the University of Texas in Dallas in 1988 (where she went to escape the north country cold). She remained in Texas where she was blessed with many wonderful friends who have always been known as her Texas family. Leo worked for Frito Lay/Pepsico from 1996 until her passing.

Leona was known for her great, easy smile and fabulous laugh. She enjoyed traveling and a bit of adventure, and truly enjoyed working in her beautiful flower garden.

She leaves behind her mother, Yvette Beloin of Colebrook, NH; her brother Pierre Beloin and his wife Tracy of Rosemeade, Calif., her sister Suzanne Carrier and her partner-in-life, Jeff Cauller, of Colebrook, her brother Guy Beloin and wife Fran of Litchfield, NH, her sister Colette Bellows of Colebrook;

She is preceded in death by her father, Alcide.
