



## Leonard D. Klebe

February 13, 1934 - July 17, 2013

COLUMBIA, NH — Mr. Leonard D. Klebe, 79, of Columbia, passed away at his home early Wednesday morning, July 17, 2013.

He was born on Feb. 13, 1934, in West Stewartstown, a son to the late Walter G. and Una (Little) Klebe. He graduated from Colebrook Academy in 1952 and then attended the Manchester Technical College to learn to be an automobile mechanic. He was later drafted in to the Army and served with honor in Germany from 1954-56.

After his military service, Leonard returned home and worked with his family on the farm at Diamond Pond for a period of time. Through his future father-in-law, Roger Young, he later became employed with the NH Dept. of Transportation, and worked for 37 years in East Colebrook and Dixville, retiring as foreman in 1994.

Known to be a private person, Leonard always loved to be at home, and he enjoyed tending to his vegetable garden. He also enjoyed fishing, and a bit of bird hunting in his younger days. He was a member of the local American Legion post in Colebrook.

He is survived by his daughter, Deborah Brooks and husband Robert of Stewartstown; two sons, Daniel Klebe and wife Carrie of Columbia, and

Darren Klebe of Columbia; a sister, Doris Jackson of Lemington, Vt.; a brother, Curtis Klebe of Colebrook; 4 grandchildren, Tara Loux of Colebrook, Mindy LaPerle of Colebrook, Kristie Brooks of Manchester, and Dawson Klebe of Stewartstown; six great-grandchildren; as well as many nieces and nephews.

Leonard is predeceased by his beloved wife, Judith (Young) Klebe; two brothers, Jesse and Robert; and a sister, Ruth Solomon.

There are no public calling hours. A graveside service with military honors will be held on Wednesday, July 24, at 11 a.m. at the Colebrook Village Cemetery.
