



Leon C. Gadwah, Jr.

Mr. Leon C. "Junior" or "Mustard" Gadwah, Jr., 72, formerly of Carlton Hill Road, Colebrook, New Hampshire, passed away Sunday, June 3, 2007, at the Coos County Nursing Hospital in West Stewartstown.
