



Lillian A. Hicks

November 29, 1925 - July 16, 2024

COLEBROOK – Lillian A. Hicks, 98, of Colebrook, died at her home on Tuesday, July 16, 2024.

She was born at sea on a trans-Atlantic ship from Ireland on Nov. 29, 1925; her mother did not survive the journey. She was adopted upon arrival in the U.S., and raised as the daughter of the late Chester A. and Elizabeth (Dobbins) Croteau of Hartford, Conn. She was raised in Connecticut, graduated from Buckley High School in Hartford, and later attended nursing school in Chicago. Lillian married Bernie Hicks, Sr. in 1949.

Her career was spent as a pediatric nurse, working in New Jersey, and until late in her life, she also was a nanny and babysitter to hundreds of children. She loved to volunteer at UCVH and at the Rec Center pool, along with her husband, for many years. Lillian was a long-time member of the Mohawk Grange, #217. She also enjoyed collecting coins, sewing, and hunting and fishing with Bernie.

At the time of her passing, Lillian was the holder of Colebrook's Boston Post Cane, having been recently recognized as the town's most senior citizen.

She is survived by her children, Deborah Brooks of Colebrook, and Douglas Hicks of Dover, N.H.; two sisters, Virginia Hungerford of South Carolina and

Marion Kenny of Connecticut; eight grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren.

Lillian is predeceased by her husband of 63 years, Bernie, in 2011; two sons, Robert Hicks and Bernie E. Hicks, Jr., as a child; and two brothers, William and Thomas Croteau.

There are no public calling hours. A graveside service will be held on Thursday, Aug. 1, 2024, at 11 a.m. in the Colebrook Village Cemetery, officiated by Pastor Cindy Grassi.
