



## Linda Reynolds

March 14, 1954 - September 17, 2010

DAVIE, FL – Linda (Bunnell) Reynolds, 56, of Ft. Lauderdale, Florida, and previously of Groveton, NH, passed away peacefully on Friday, September 17, 2010, after a lengthy illness.

She was born in West Stewartstown, NH, on March 14, 1954, the daughter of the late Kenneth Bunnell and Wilma (Haynes) Bunnell. Linda was a graduate of Pittsburg High School, Class of 1972, and New Hampshire Technical College in Berlin, NH, in 1995 where she earned the President's Award for the highest cumulative grade point average in her class.

When Linda lived in Groveton she was a popular and well-known waitress at the Town House, as well as Olde Susannah's in Lancaster. After moving to Ft. Lauderdale she worked for Broward Trucking and Equipment.

Linda loved horses and spent many happy times with her family at local horse pulling events. She enjoyed traveling and saw much of the country with her former husband, Daniel Reynolds. Linda also discovered, with the help of her sisters, that a trip to the casino could brighten an otherwise bleak day.

Linda leaves two sons, Toby Reynolds of Groveton, NH, and Troy Reynolds of Baltimore, MD. Additionally, she leaves two sisters, Dencie Donovan and husband Robert, of Ft. Lauderdale, with whom she lived, and Jean Lugli and

husband John, of West Hartford, Conn. Linda cherished her three grandchildren, Amelia, Trevor, and Connor, and her great-grandson, Carter. She had five nieces and nephews who loved her dearly, one of whom wisely observed at a young age that, "Auntie Yinda knows everything!" Linda's family will miss her.

She was predeceased by a brother, Stanley Bunnell, of Clarksville, NH.

There are no calling hours. A memorial service will be held on Saturday, October 2, 2010, at 11 a.m. at the Trinity United Methodist Church in Colebrook, NH, with The Rev. Rick Boyden officiating. A committal service will follow at the Colebrook Village Cemetery.
