Lindy is survived by her three sons, Lynn Wheeler of Hampton, N.H., David Lombard of Milford, N.H., and Edward Tilton of Colebrook; a brother, Larry Wheeler of Auburn, Mass.; six grandchildren and 2 great-grandchildren; as well as numerous nieces and nephews.

She is predeceased by a brother, Joe Massey and his wife Patricia, and a

sister, Patricia Parker.
