October 20, 1965 - October 3, 2012

EAST CORINTH, VT—Mrs. Lisa Marie Davis, 46, of East Corinth, Vt., and formerly of Colebrook, passed away on Wednesday morning, Oct. 3, 2012, at the Gifford Medical Center in Randolph, Vt., after a long and courageous battle with cancer.

She was born in Somerville, Mass., on Oct. 20, 1965, a daughter to the late Anna Winston. She was educated in Somerville, and later moved with her family to New Hampshire's north country, where she attended the White Mountain Community College in Berlin, NH, and later attained her bachelor's degree in human services from Springfield College.
