



Lloyd A. Tirrill

October 27, 1934 - September 29, 2021

PHOENIX, AZ – Beloved family man and friend, Lloyd A. Tirrill, 86, went home to the Lord in the early morning hours from his home in Phoenix, Ariz., on Wednesday, Sept. 29, 2021, after a long illness.

A native son of Vermont, Lloyd graduated from Canaan High School in 1953. He married his sweetheart, Doris, in 1955, while serving in the U.S. Air Force, stationed in Michigan. Lloyd later attended and graduated from the University of Michigan with a degree in electrical engineering. A lifelong career with Hughes Aircraft company took Lloyd and Doris and their three daughters, Cindy, Laurie, and Beth, from one end of the country to the other on field assignments at over 10 Air Force bases in the United States. Lloyd served in the Civil Air Patrol for 53 years retiring at the rank of Lt. Colonel.

Lloyd leaves a beautiful legacy of 3 children, 8 grandchildren, 12 great-grandchildren, along with his only sister Beverly Dey, 2 sons-in-law, 3 nieces, 1 nephew, and many friends from coast to coast.

Lloyd will be buried in Canaan near the Tirrill farmhouse. The glorious fall colors will be a beautiful farewell. Lloyd said to tell all, “I hope to see you on the other side!” “Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life. No man cometh unto the Father but by me.” John 14:6

A memorial service will be held at the Hope Baptist Church on Wednesday, Oct. 13, 2021, at 1 p.m. in West Stewartstown with Pastor Paul Levang officiating. A graveside interment service with military honors will follow at 3 p.m. in the Canaan Village Cemetery.
