



Lorraine I. Tratzinski

COLEBROOK, NH —Lorraine I. Tratzinski, 65, passed away on Friday, March 7, 2014, at the Dartmouth-Hitchcock Medical Center in Lebanon, NH.

She was born in Brockton, Mass., on Oct. 26, 1948, a daughter to James and Barbara (Monast) Lincoln. Lorraine was a 1964 graduate of Brockton High School.

Lorraine was a dedicated homemaker for her family, but she also worked as a CNA for a time at the Coös County Nursing Hospital. She loved to fish and be outdoors, and she loved music, especially classic country & western. Lorraine was also an accomplished guitar player. She was fond of doing different crafts, and she was a talented artist known for her drawings. She was very giving and always helping others in some way. Living by her motto, “less is more,” Lorraine also was a strong-willed, independent woman, and a true patriot who loved her country. She was an avid fan of the Red Sox and the N.E. Patriots.

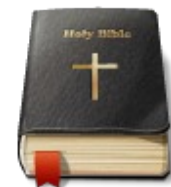
