



## Lorraine D. Duquette

February 21, 1927 - May 23, 2012

WEST STEWARTSTOWN, NH—Lorraine D. Duquette, 85, of West Stewartstown, and formerly of Colebrook, passed away early on Wednesday morning, May 23, 2012, at the Coos County Nursing Hospital in West Stewartstown, where she had been a resident for the past six years.

She was born in Pittsburg, NH, on February 21, 1927, a daughter to the late Narcisse and Roseaine (Deblois) Duquette. She was the youngest of seven children.
