



Lorrie M. Byrnes

September 22, 1953 - October 7, 2022

PITTSBURG – Lorrie M. (Robbins) Byrnes, 69, of Pittsburg, passed away unexpectedly on Friday, Oct. 7, 2022, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook after a sudden illness at her home.

She was born on Sept. 22, 1953, in Weymouth, Mass., a daughter to the late Charles and Carolyn (Walker) Robbins.

Lorrie attended the Pembroke school system and graduated from Silver Lake Regional High School, Class of 1971, in Kingston, Mass. She belonged to several softball leagues and bowling teams, and years later joined the same after coming to Pittsburg. She enjoyed walking in the woods to see what nature had to offer while looking for deer and moose antlers, and picking mushrooms. She also enjoyed snowmobiling in the winter months.

Lorrie's door was always open to anyone in need, especially local teenagers and friends of her children; they became her family, too. Throughout her life, she certainly marched to the beat of her own drum. Her greatest joy and treasure was her grandchildren, and they were all the love of her life.

For many years, Lorrie worked at the Beecher Falls Division of Ethan Allen, and she owned and operated Robbins Cabins on Back Lake in Pittsburg. For the past several years, she was a familiar face to all as she worked at Young's

Store.

Lorrie leaves behind her three children and their father, Christian Byrnes (Kara Sue) of Colebrook, Lisa Byrnes-Smart of Bradford, N.H., Aaron Byrnes of Pittsburg, and Philip “Jack” Byrnes of North Weymouth, Mass.; three sisters, Linda Robbins-Porazzo of Pembroke, Mass., Lois A. Pento of Plympton, Mass., and Leanne J. Kelley (Edward) of Pembroke; five grandchildren, Jack and Brody Smart, Chase, Raedan and Oakley Byrnes; and her furry canine companion, Jax.
