



Louis Y. Thibodeau

August 6, 1969 - July 8, 2021

STEWARTSTOWN – Louis Y. Thibodeau, 51, of Stewartstown, died tragically on Thursday, July 8, 2021, on his way to work after being stricken with a sudden medical condition that also resulted in an automobile accident.

He was born on Aug. 6, 1969, in Rochester, N.Y., a son to Rejean L. and Therese (Riendeau) Thibodeau. He was raised in Connecticut and graduated from Enrico Fermi High School in 1987.

Louis was a hard worker his entire life, and he was a skilled carpenter and drywaller, and loved to do finish work carpentry. At the time of his passing, he was a valuable and beloved member of Kevin Lassonde's construction team in Pittsburg.

Family was everything to Louis and he cherished his two sons. He loved the Thibodeau family land and loved to be outdoors. In his spare time, he could be found outside hunting, fishing, 4-wheeling or snowmobiling, and he also enjoyed trapping.

Louis leaves behind his two sons, Andrew and Adam Thibodeau of Enfield, Conn.; his mother, Therese Thibodeau of Stewartstown; his sister, Vicky Thibodeau and her fiancé Craig Mayo of Stewartstown; and two nephews, Hunter and Stephen Roy of Stewartstown.

He is predeceased by his father, Rejean Thibodeau, in 2012.

There are no public calling hours. A celebration of Louis' life will be held at the Outback Pub & Spa in W. Stewartstown on Saturday, July 24, from 1 to 3 p.m.
