



Louisa S. Dostie

February 1, 1941 - October 28, 2015

STEWARTSTOWN – Louisa S. Dostie, 74, of Stewartstown, NH, passed away on Wednesday evening, Oct. 28, 2015, at the Coös County Nursing Hospital with members of her family by her side.

She was born in Norton, Vt., on Feb. 1, 1941, a daughter to the late Trefley and Rose (Ruel) Sage. Louisa attended school in Stanhope, Que., and later married André J. Dostie on March 24, 1962.

The Dosties were known far and wide for their successful furniture business, first in Stewartstown, and later in Colebrook from 1980-2007. Louisa was a self-made and self-taught accomplished businesswoman. Even though an accomplished seamstress, no one ever taught her about upholstery and drapery—she learned how to do it on her own.

In her spare time, Louisa enjoyed walking, and was often seen by her friends walking around town. She loved to spend time with her grandchildren, and she loved to be among her flower gardens when at home. She will always be remembered by her loved ones as the “rock of the family.”

She leaves behind her loving husband of more than 52 years, André J. Dostie of Colebrook; two sons, Denis Dostie and wife Chantal of Stewartstown, and Donald Dostie and Cara Lariviere of Columbia; three grandchildren, Andre, Adrien and Natalie Dostie; a brother, Tref Sage of Nashua, NH; and a sister, Sue Sage of Shelburne, Vt.

Louisa is preceded in death by two sisters, Irene Cusson and Simone Houle.

Memorial calling hours will be on Monday, Nov. 2, 2015, from Noon to 2 p.m. at the Jenkins & Newman Funeral Home in Colebrook. A graveside committal service will immediately follow at St. Brendan’s Cemetery in Colebrook.
