COLEBROOK, NH -- Mr. Louis A. Roy, 81, of Colebrook, NH, passed away on Saturday afternoon, July 2, 2011, at the Weeks Medical Center in Lancaster, NH, after a long period of declining health.

Louis was born on February 12, 1930, in Winchester, Conn., a son to the late Donat and Catherine (Arnold) Roy. He was educated in Connecticut and later served with honor in the U.S. Navy during the era of the Korean conflict.

Prior to moving to the north country, Louis worked for General Electric in Connecticut for 13 years. After moving to Canaan, Vt., and then Colebrook, he worked for 17 years in the shipping department at the Beecher Falls Division of Ethan Allen. He was an avid hunter and fisherman, and he truly enjoyed his time spent deep sea fishing. Louis enjoyed watching westerns on television, and he also loved to watch "Who Wants To Be A Millionaire?"

He leaves behind his beloved wife of 39 years, Lorraine (Harding) Roy of Colebrook; two daughters, Nancy Purrington and husband, Nathan, of Colebrook, and Carmen Rougeau and husband, Richard of Canaan, Vt.; four grandchildren; two great-grandchildren; and his beloved canine companion, Bumper.
