



Lyford E. Parker Sr.

July 17, 1936 - November 10, 2020

COLEBROOK – Lyford E. Parker, Sr., 84, of Colebrook, passed away on Tuesday, Nov. 10, 2020, at the Coös County Nursing Hospital in West Stewartstown after a long period of declining health and with members of his family by his side.

He was born in West Stewartstown on July 17, 1936, a son to the late Earl W. Parker and Anne Mae (Ricker) Bumford.

Lyford was a proud truck driver for his working career. He started his truck driving career at age 16 with his half-brother, Leonard Parker Sr., driving log trucks. Eventually he moved on to driving log truck for Laval Corriveau and ended his career at age 70 driving an oil tanker truck for Colebrook Oil/C.N. Brown . Lyford's favorite things to do were riding his Honda Goldwing motorcycle, running his Ford F150 plow truck, and spending time with his favorite dog, Fluffy.

Lyford leaves behind his beloved partner of more than 44 years, Reona Hartlen of West Stewartstown; three children, Tamie Marsh, Lyford E. Parker, Jr., and Amanda Parker; two grandchildren, Collette Marsh and her fiancé, Todd Martel, Rhiannon Wilkie and her husband, Jared; and 5 great-grandchildren, Dawson Scott-Marsh, Dagan Parker, Deniyah, Anesha, and Collin Wilkie.

He is predeceased by a son, Timothy E. Parker in 2014, a daughter, Tina M. Parker in 2017, and his beloved dog, Fluffy.
