STEWARTSTOWN, NH – Mabel A. Owen, 93, of Stewartstown, NH, passed away Saturday morning, August 27, 2011, at the Coös County Nursing Hospital in West Stewartstown after a period of failing health.

She was born in Stewartstown, NH, on August 13, 1918, a daughter to the late Sydney and Beryl (McAllaster) Stanton and was educated in the local schools.

For all of her adult life, Mabel was a loving homemaker for her family, and she also served as the housekeeper for the Newman Funeral Home in the early 1940s. She was a member of the old Grange in Stewartstown, and a member of the Trinity United Methodist Church in Colebrook.
