September 18, 1939 - September 20, 2019

WEST STEWARTSTOWN — Madeleine “Mado” Pariseau, 80, of West Stewartstown, passed away on Friday, Sept. 20, 2019, at her home after a long battle with cancer and with her family by her side.

She was born in St. Venant de Paquette, Québec, on Sept. 18, 1939, a daughter to the late Adrien and Rose (Gregoire) Lavigne. She and her husband emigrated to the U.S. in 1962 after their marriage.

Mado was a great mother and proud grandmother. She loved spending time with her grandchildren and taking care of her family. She enjoyed her afternoon coffees with friends, and she also loved to be with her brothers and sisters. She was a faithful communicant at St. Albert’s Church.
