



Madeline E. Parkhurst

August 17, 1905 - September 8, 2010

WEST STEWARTSTOWN, NH -- Mrs. Madeline E. Parkhurst, 105, of West Stewartstown, died Wednesday evening, September 8, 2010, at the Coös County Nursing Hospital in West Stewartstown, where she had been a resident for eight years.

She was born in Columbia, NH, on August 17, 1905, a daughter of Harley and Eva (McCullough) Gadwah. She attended school in Columbia and was raised on the family farm. After school, Madeline attended the Rubican Business College in St. Louis, Missouri for a time before returning to the north country.

Madeline loved her life on the farm and spent her years as a homemaker. She loved her flower gardens, and she was an excellent cook. She also enjoyed watching the birds around the house and always kept her birdfeeders full. She will be missed by all her family and will be remembered as a loving wife, mother, and grandmother.

She leaves behind two sons, Kenneth Parkhurst and wife Isabelle of Columbia, NH, and Winston Parkhurst of West Stewartstown, NH; a sister, Dorothy Decapot of Salt Lake City, Utah; four grandchildren; eight great-grandchildren; and numerous great-great grandchildren.

Mrs. Parkhurst is preceded in death by her husband, Lynn Parkhurst, in 1979;

and a son, Erwin Parkhurst in 2003; two brothers, Herbert and Durwood Gadwah; and two sisters, Gleigh Kelsea and Lucy Mullarkey.

Calling hours will be on Saturday morning, September 11, 2010, from 9 – 11 a.m. at Jenkins & Newman Funeral Home in Colebrook, NH. 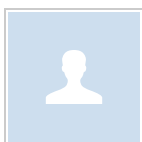
