



Marcelle M. Day

July 24, 1932 - March 8, 2013

WEST STEWARTSTOWN, NH— Mrs. Marcelle M. Day, 80, of West Stewartstown, NH, passed away at the Coös County Nursing Hospital in West Stewartstown on Friday morning, March 8, 2013, with her loving husband by her side, and after a long period of declining health.

She was born in Colebrook on July 24, 1932, the only daughter of the late Albert and Almoza (Favreau) Shaw. Marcelle was a graduate of Colebrook Academy in 1950.

Her career of more than 30 years was as an administrative secretary and later as an office manager for PSNH in Colebrook and Berlin. Marcelle was a music lover, especially classic country & western and gospel. She was particularly fond of the sound of the big bands of the 1940s. She also enjoyed ice skating and roller skating, and she loved to dance. Her faith was very important to her, and she regularly attended the Independent Baptist Church in West Stewartstown. Marcelle will be remembered as a loving wife and mother, grandmother, sister and aunt, and she will be dearly missed by all her family and friends.

She is survived by her loving husband of more than 60 years, Merton “Buddy” Day of West Stewartstown; her son Ronald Day and wife Evie of Canaan, Vt.; her daughter, Susan Burns and husband Philip of York, Me.; a brother, Robert

Shaw and wife Linda of Colebrook; eight grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.

Marcelle is preceded in death by a daughter, Barbara Jean, as a toddler.

A funeral service will be held on Tuesday, March 12, 2013, at 11 a.m. at the Independent Baptist Church in West Stewartstown, with Pastor Matthew Coons officiating. Calling hours will be at the church just prior to the service from 9 to 11 a.m. Interment will occur in the spring at the Colebrook Village Cemetery.
