January 25, 1935 - May 15, 2022

BLOOMFIELD – Marguerite E. Breault, 87, of Bloomfield, died at her home on Sunday morning, May 15, 2022, with her children at her side after many months of declining health.

She was born in Bloomfield on Jan. 25, 1935, a daughter to the late Charles T. and Minnie (Gendron) Lavoie.

For 17 years, Marguerite worked as a splice operator at the Stratford Plywood Mill, but later worked in the Washburn bobbin mill for a short period and then at Lambert's grocery store in Colebrook. She retired as a meat wrapper at LaPerle's IGA after working there for 25 years.

Marguerite was a life-long and faithful communicant at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in North Stratford. She and her husband were both animals lovers.

She is survived by her two children, David Breault of Bloomfield and Annmarie Breault of Bloomfield; one granddaughter, Laura Breault of Colebrook; and a great-grandson, Axton Leandre Breault.

She is preceded in death by her husband, Leandre 'Pete' Breault in 2016; two sons, Peter Breault and Robert Breault as an infant; and three sisters, Rosemarie Breault, Claire DeLong, and Anna Jean Lavoie.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be held the next day, Friday, May 20, at 11 a.m. at the Sacred Heart Catholic Church in North Stratford, with The Rev. Daniel Deveau as celebrant.
