COLEBROOK – Marilla J. Dorman-Smith, 80, of Colebrook died peacefully on Monday, June 1, 2020, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook after a long period of declining health.

She was born on May 3, 1940, in Columbia, a daughter of the late Jesse L. and Lillian (Coates) Cass, Sr. Marilla attended schools in both Columbia and Colebrook.

For a short time, she worked in the Plywood Products mill in North Stratford. She later worked at the Beecher Falls Division of Ethan Allen for many years, in the finishing department, eventually rising to the position of night shift supervisor from which she retired in 1999. She would return to Ethan Allen occasionally, when called, for special projects.

Marilla was a long-time member of the Grace United Methodist Church in Canaan, and she loved to travel, knit and sew, and spend time with her grandchildren. She will be lovingly remembered and missed by all those who learned the lyrics of "You Are My Sunshine " while being rocked in her arms.

She leaves behind her husband of almost 14 years, Lincoln L. Smith of Colebrook; a daughter, Leis Dobson and husband, Robert, of Bennett, Colo.; a sister, Geraldine Pettingill of Colebrook; multiple grandchildren and great-

grandchildren; as well as numerous nieces, nephews, and cousins.

Marilla is predeceased by an infant son, Richard L. Holden, Jr., husband Sherman Dorman in 2001; six brothers, Dean, Earl, Roland, Morris, Robert and Jesse Cass., Jr.; and two sisters, Leis Mullek and Margaret Kenney.

Due to restrictions on public gatherings, a private interment will take place at a later date in the Pittsburg Hollow Cemetery.
