NORTH STRATFORD, NH— Mrs. Marilyn C. Burns, 84, of North Stratford, passed away on Saturday afternoon, May 4, 2013, at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook after a long period of declining health.

She was born in Clarksville, NH, on December 9, 1928, a daughter to the late Bill and Clara (Mullen) Wheeler. She attended local schools and later was married to Roy Burns in 1950.

great-grandchildren; a brother, Willie Wheeler of Browns Mills, New Jersey; a sister, Ruth Pineo of Canaan, Vt.; as well as numerous nieces and nephews.

She is predeceased by her husband of 37 years, Roy Burns in 1987; six brothers, Glen, William "Buster", Albert, Stewart, Stanley, and Donald; and an infant sister, Dorothy.
