COLUMBIA, NH—Mrs. Marion L. Stanton, 85, of Columbia, NH, passed away peacefully at her residence early Sunday morning, March 10, 2013, after a long illness and surrounded by her loving family.

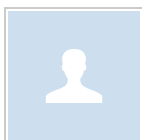
