



Dr. Mary Louise Lovering

January 13, 1932 - September 2, 2019

CANAAN – Dr. Mary Louise C. Lovering, 87, of Beecher Falls, Vt., passed to eternal life at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital in Colebrook on Monday, Sept. 2, 2019, after a brief period of declining health.

She was born in Richford, Vt., on Jan. 13, 1932, a daughter to the late Lewis R. and Vivian M. (Rooney) Lovering. She attended the Canaan schools and graduated from Canaan Memorial High School in 1950. She then pursued her higher education in nursing at the Mary Fletcher Hospital School of Nursing and later a baccalaureate degree in education and public health nursing from Syracuse University. She later earned a Master of Science degree from the Boston College School of Nursing and doctorate in Education Policy, Research & Administration from the University of Massachusetts at Amherst.

Mary Lou then began a long career as a nursing professor in Greenfield and Worcester, Mass., and was the Director of Nursing Education at the former Hahnemann Hospital School of Nursing in Worcester. She later joined the faculty at Worcester State College in 1974 and taught there for 26 years, retiring in 2000 as a full professor and chair of the Dept. of Nursing.

She was always very active in the college and the community while at Worcester State. She was also active in many nursing organizations, serving as president of the Massachusetts / Rhode Island League for Nursing from

1978-1980, and in the Sigma Theta Tau International Honor Society in Nursing, serving as president of the local chapter, Iota Phi at Large. Mary Lou was the secretary of the Massachusetts State College Association, Worcester Chapter, and served on the All College Council.

After her retirement and relocation back to Canaan, she was no less active, and served her town as a library volunteer, as the Town Health Officer, as a clerk for the Canaan Fire District, #2. She was a faithful communicant of St. Albert's Parish, also serving as lector, Eucharistic minister and catechist for the church. Mary Lou was also an avid reader, with a strong belief in education, and she was exceptionally devoted to her family.

Mary Lou is survived by 11 nieces and nephews, Michael O'Brien, Edward O'Brien, Susan Dively, Patricia Baron, Catherine Cooper, Nancy Jones, Phyllis O'Brien, Christopher Doyle, Kevin Doyle, Anthony Doyle and Karen (Doyle) Culhane; 23 great-nieces and great-nephews; as well as 11 great-great nieces and nephews.

She is predeceased by all her siblings, Ellen Doyle, Eileen McCollum, Mahlon F. O'Brien, James "Pat" O'Brien, and William Lovering.

Memorial calling hours will be on Saturday morning, Sept. 7, 2019, from 10 to 11:30 a.m. at the Jenkins & Newman Funeral Home in Colebrook, NH. A memorial Mass will be celebrated immediately after at Noon at St. Albert's Church in West Stewartstown. Interment in the Canaan Village Cemetery will be at a later date of which notice will be given.

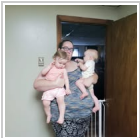
