



## Matthew A. Elliott

September 12, 1927 - September 27, 2011

COLEBROOK, NH-- Mr. Matthew A. Elliott, 84, of Colebrook, NH, passed away at his residence late on Tuesday evening, September 27, 2011.

He was born in Westford, Mass., on September 12, 1927, to the late Augustus R. and Beatrice (Dapkus) Elliott. Matt was educated in Westford and joined the U.S. Navy in 1944 at the age of 17, serving with honor in the Asiatic-Pacific theater of World War II.

He was a plumber by trade, and worked for several years in Massachusetts after his military service, before moving to Colebrook in 1983. He continued as a plumber, working for his sister at the Colebrook House, and later for Daniel Hebert, Inc., from which he retired.

Matt was an avid fisherman and he loved to dabble in woodwork. He was a fixture at the Colebrook House of Pizza for many years, often holding court with his friends there every day. He loved to talk politics, and ran for Colebrook planning board in 2008. He adored his grandchildren and great-grandchildren, and he will be dearly missed by them and his friends.

He is survived by his daughter, Peggy Giguere of Colebrook; a step-son, Mark Mortimer of Fitchburg, Mass.; three brothers, Buddy Elliott of Florida, Ross Elliott of Rutland, Vt., and Francis Elliott of Florida; a sister, Ellen Elliott of

Florida; three grandchildren; and three great-grandchildren.

Matt is preceded in death by his loving wife, Margaret (Black) Elliott in 2005; a brother, Joseph Elliott; and a sister, Katherine Wetherby.
