COLUMBIA – Michael A. Grandmaison, 71, of Columbia, passed away at his home on Saturday, Nov. 6, 2021.

He was born in West Stewartstown on June 30, 1950, a son to the late Louis and Berthe (Lemieux) Grandmaison. He and his siblings attended the local schools and were proud to be first-generation Americans. Mike was among one of the last graduating classes of the Academy of Our Lady of Grace in Colebrook.

From an early age, he and his brother helped their father in his logging company, Green Mountain Logging, as well as helping on the dairy farm, and Mike also spent his summers driving trucks from the age of 16. Eventually, Mike went on to form his own logging and woods products operation, employing many, many local loggers and others over the years.

He loved to go fishing and hunting, and he always loved running heavy equipment. He was proud of his homes and always had to have a pond nearby. In retirement, Mike had a daily routine that he enjoyed, socializing and breakfasting each day at the Wilderness Restaurant. His many friends will all miss their daily visits with him. He was especially close to his family and so very proud of his grandchildren.

He leaves behind his two daughters, Christa Howe-Lambert (James) of Colebrook, and Erica Owen (Craig) of East Burke, Vt., and their mother Sharon of Colebrook; three sisters, Ginette Pariseau of Colebrook, Diane Fournier (Peter) of Hooksett, N.H., and Nicole Brockney of St. Johnsbury, Vt.; and four grandchildren, Savannah and Samantha Howe and Maison and Grant Owen.

Mike is predeceased by an infant son, Luc, in 1984, and a brother, L. Renaud Grandmaison in 2020.

There will be no public calling hours. A graveside interment service will be held on Thursday, Nov. 11, 2021, at 1 p.m. at St. Brendan's Cemetery in Colebrook.

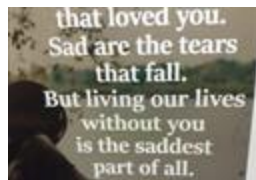
