COLEBROOK – Michael G. Moren, 70, of Colebrook, died at the Coos Country Nursing Hospital in W. Stewartstown on Wednesday, Aug. 7, 2024, after a long period of ill health.

He was born in W. Stewartstown on Oct. 5, 1953, a son to Gordon and Georgena (Washburn) Moren.
