ERROL, NEW HAMPSHIRE – Mrs. Mona E. Eames, 86, of Errol, NH, passed away at the home of her daughter on the afternoon of Wednesday, July 12, 2006, after a long illness and surrounded by her loving family. Mrs. Eames was born October 19, 1919, in Lincoln Plantation, Wilson’s Mills, Maine, daughter of the late Ernest Bennett and Vesta (Barrows) Bennett. Mrs. Eames is survived by four children, Elsie Hall and husband, David, of Errol, NH, Norman “Pete” Eames of Errol, NH, Carlton Eames and wife, Cynthia, of Errol, NH, and Chester Eames and wife, Bonnie, of Goffstown, NH; fourteen grandchildren, sixteen great-grandchildren, and numerous nieces, nephews and cousins. She is preceded in death by her husband, Everett, in August of 2005; an infant daughter in 1939; one brother, Lauren Bennett; and three sisters, Marjorie Littlehale, Marna Eastman, and Mary Jordan.
