COLEBROOK – Monda L. Anderson, 79, of Colebrook, passed away unexpectedly at the Upper Connecticut Valley Hospital on Tuesday morning, Sept. 13, 2022.

She was born on March 10, 1943, in Milo, Maine, a daughter to the late Chester and Mary (Savage) Sawyer. She was raised in Waltham, Mass., and was a graduate of Waltham High School.
